MANAGE SLIDERS

Click Image Slider > Manage Group to start.

A Group (or a Slider) is a set of images to be shown. To add new Group, click “Add Group”.

Add a Group (or Slider)

In tab **General Information**:

- Title: title of slider group to be shown in Manage Group list.
- Store Views: choose the store view in which this slider appears.
- Description: a short description about how this slider is all about.
- Status: Enable/disable this slider.

In tab Style Setting:

Here we define parameter values to control the look and feel of the Slider on frontend.

Style Setting: control the general settings of the Slider.

- Auto Play: control the ability to auto play the slide.
- Banner Width, Banner Height: the dimensions of the slide (in pixels). Its recommended to resize slider's images to exactly this size.
- Show Direction Navigation: show/hide the Prev, Next buttons.
- Show Control Navigation: show/hide the navigation buttons below the slide.
- Pause On Hover: whether to pause the slide when on mouse hover.

Text Setting: control the the text (image description) appearance.

- Text Size: size of text
- Text Color: color of text
- Text Margin: margin of text
- Text Background Color: background color of text
- Text Background Transparency: background transparency.

Transition Setting: control transition effects of Slide

- Slider Effect: choose one of the many beautiful effects Image Slider supports. You can choose the Random effect to display all as well.
- Transition Speed
- Transition Delay Time
- Start Slide: define which image to start the slide

Theme Setting: there are multiple theme preset for you to select.

- Theme slide: choose a theme.

After entering all, click “Save And Continue Edit”. You will then notice that “Add Image” will appear, this allows you to add images of Slide. Click “Add Image” to proceed.

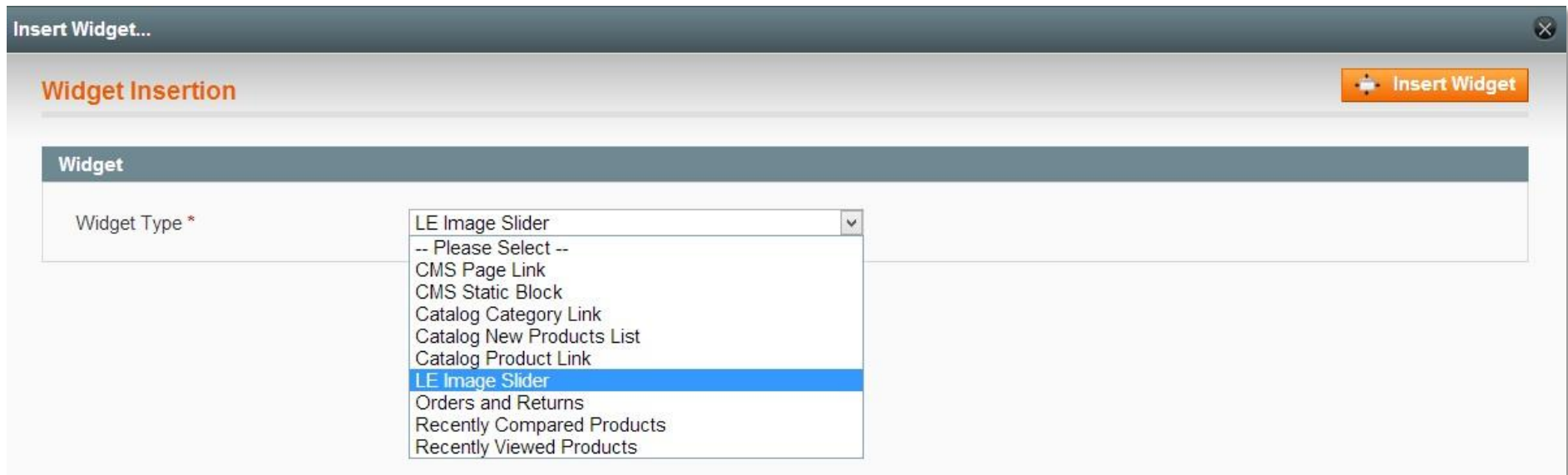

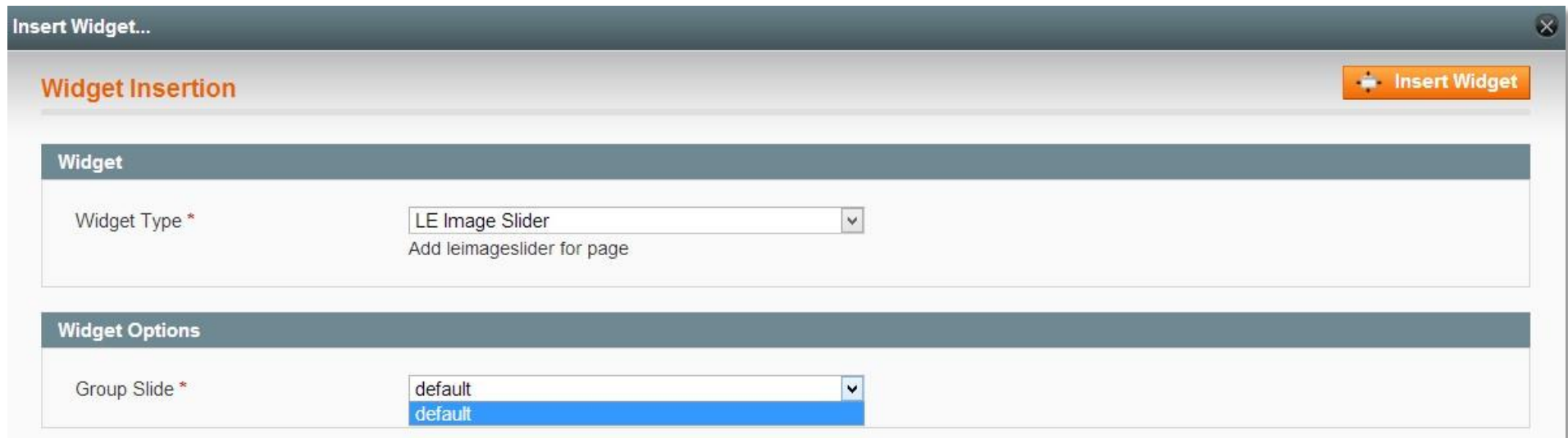
Method 1: Insert the Slider in CMS page.

In backend, Click CMS > Page.

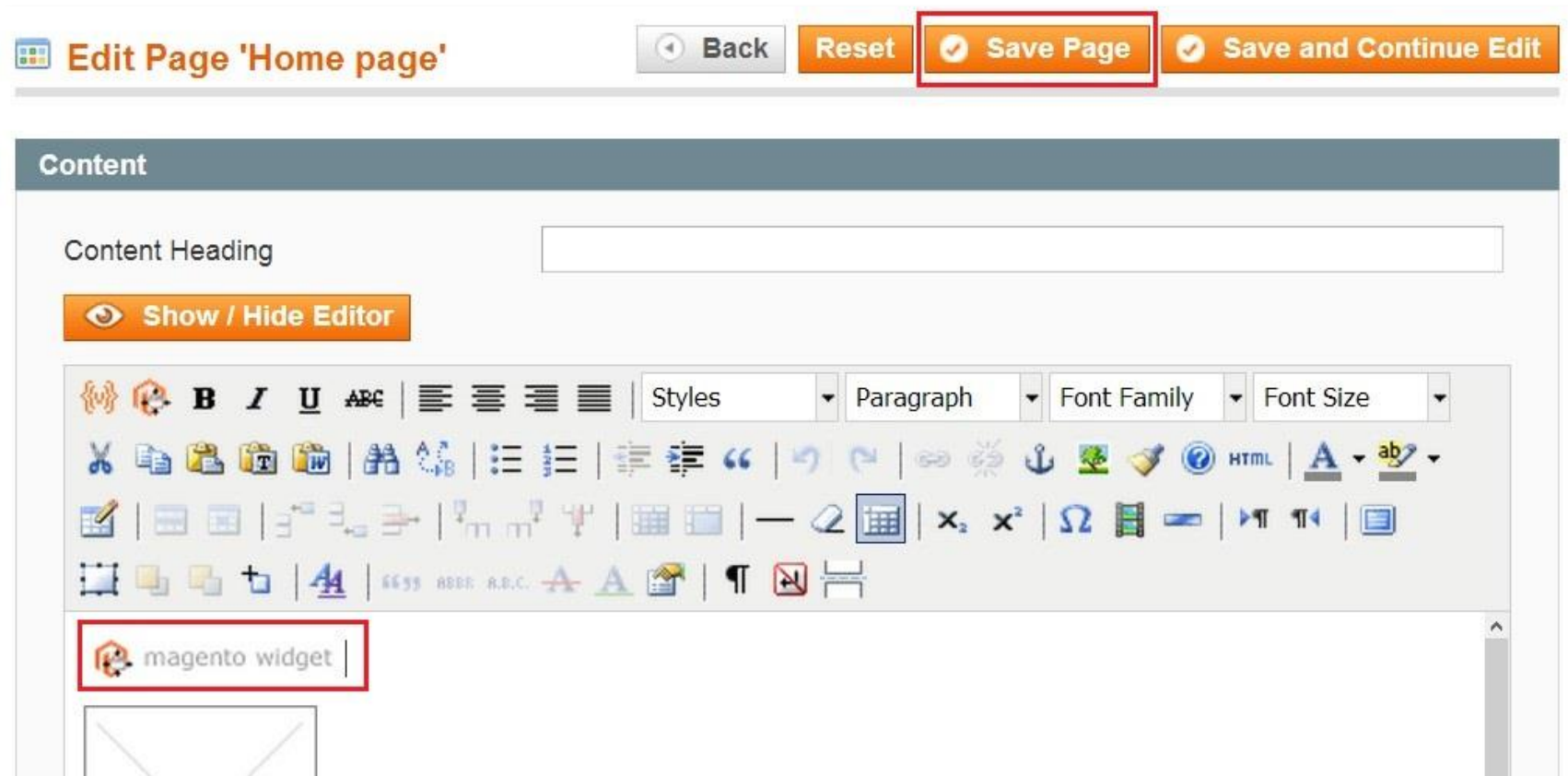
Choose the CMS page to display the slider. In tab Content, choose the icon "Insert Widget". Insert Widget window will appear. Choose Widget Type "LE Image Slider".



Next, choose one of the precreated Slide that you want to show and click Insert Widget.



Widget will appear in content. Click Save.
